2. HOW CAN UNIVERSITIES PARTICIPATE?

1. Through the Online Global Platform www.universitiespa.org

- Including RSU projects for their publication
- Informing and publishing research and other activities
- Contribute to the economic management of the platform

2. Through UNIVERSITY PROJECTS

- Offer pro-bono collaboration from the University staff to projects that are being developed by other institutions.
- Collaborate in the execution of good practices together with the companies
- Find internships for their students in companies
- Facilitate scholarships for students without financial resources and young professors conducting research
- Contribute to the financing of projects

3. Through INTERNATIONAL FORUMS

- Participate together with companies, institutions and governments
- Promote multidisciplinary innovation ecosystems for poverty alleviation, sustainable development and inequality by fostering student associations, curricular and extracurricular practices, dissertations, research ...
- Promote the patronage of alumni organizations and companies in the initiatives for poverty alleviation, sustainable development and inequality; such as student competitions, social startups, awards...
- Sponsor, in their case, international forums.
