

## Henning Jensen-Pennington

Henning Jensen-Pennington studied Psychology and Philosophy in Costa Rica and Germany; in the University of Friburgo he obtained the graduate degree of *Diplom-Psychologe* and a Doctorate in Philosophy (Psychology). He has been the director of the Institute for Psychological Research, Dean of Faculty for Social Sciences, Director of Doctorate Studies of Society and Culture, and Vice-rector of Research for the University of Costa Rica. He has been the consultant of the Pan-American Organization of Health and President of the College of Psychology of Costa Rica. From 2004 to 2011 he was the chair of the Foundation of the University of Costa Rica for Research. He has been the national point of contact for the Seventh Framework Program of the European Union for Costa Rica. He has published numerous scientific articles in the areas of psychosomatic medicine, socio-epidemiology, clinical psychology, epistemology of psychoanalysis, critical theory of the subject, social psychology of political processes, and transcultural aspects of early mother/ infant relationships. Throughout his publications you can find a compilation of various essays titled *Walter Benjamin. Crítica-Melancolía-Rendeción* (Editorial of the University of Costa Rica, 2008). He is the Rector of the University of Costa Rica from 2012 to 2016.
