The partnership between the Volunteers of the Organization of Sertão and the Central University of Barão de Mauá - CBM- cover the area of the northeast region, precisely the interior of Bahia. Teachers and students of medicine and nursing courses of CBM,



have the opportunity to provide services to select communities, exercising their acquired knowledge.

Students of bachelor degrees in Education, Literature and History have a requirement for their training of periodic visits to selected communities, with new methods and materials in order to improve the literacy process and fundamentally train local literacy teachers involved in the project.
